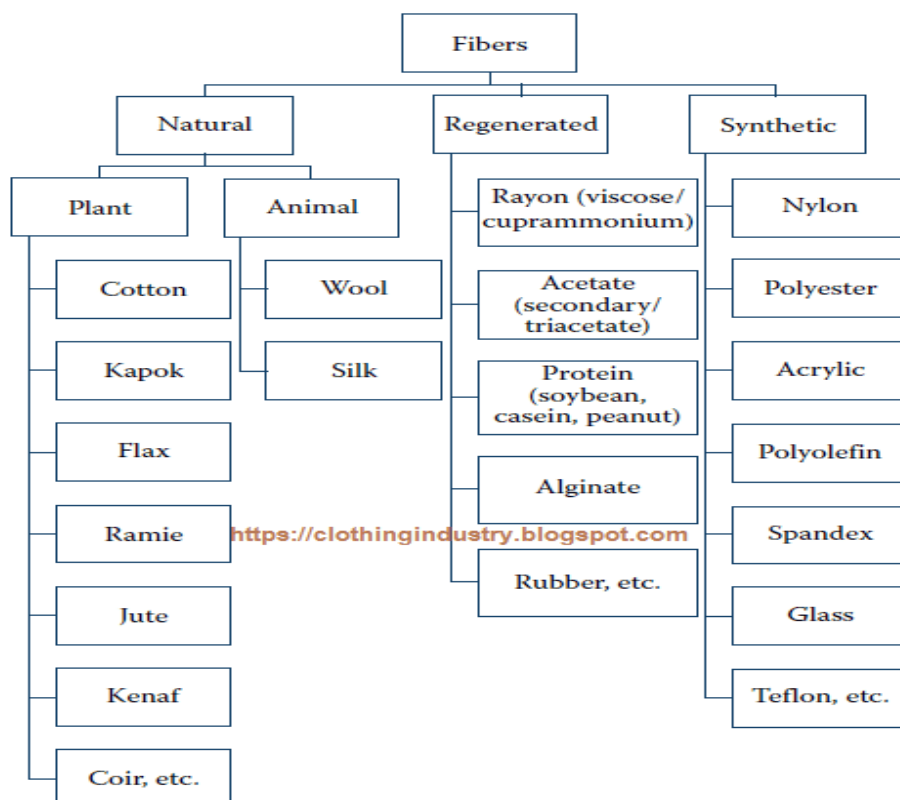

Regenerated-fibers

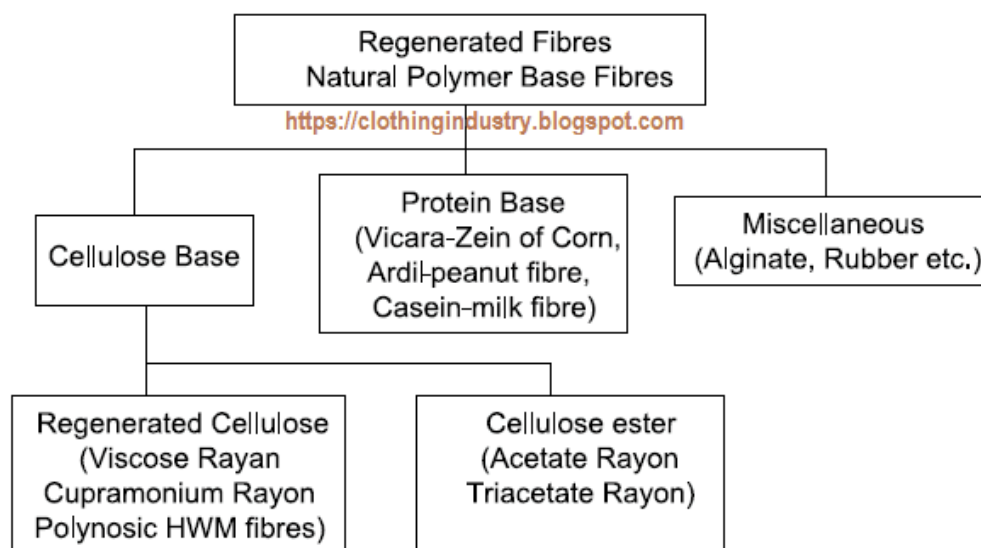

Synthetic-fibers

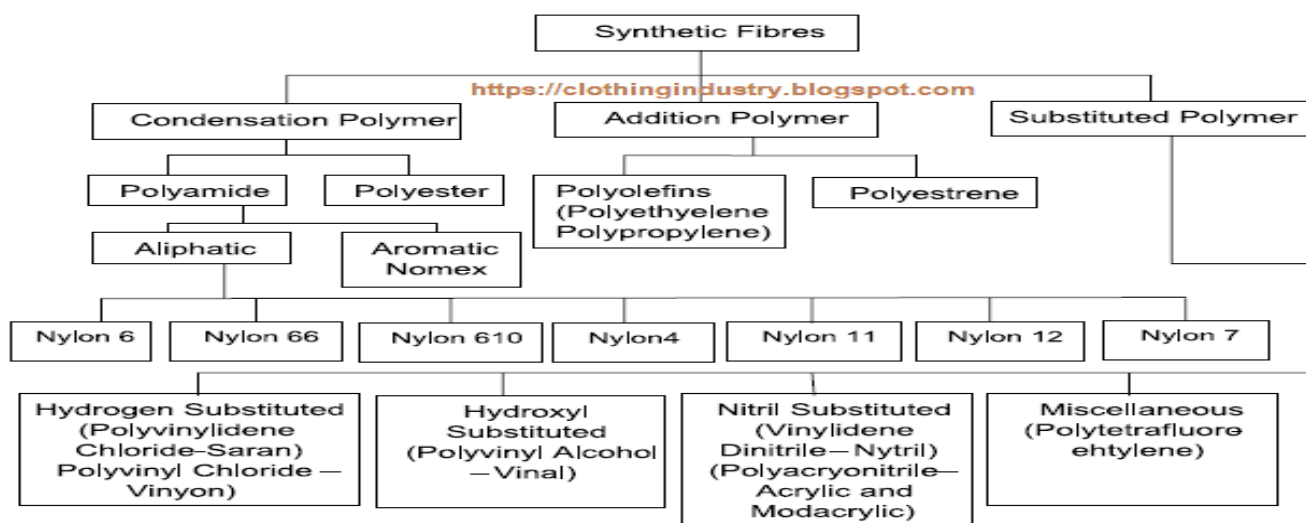

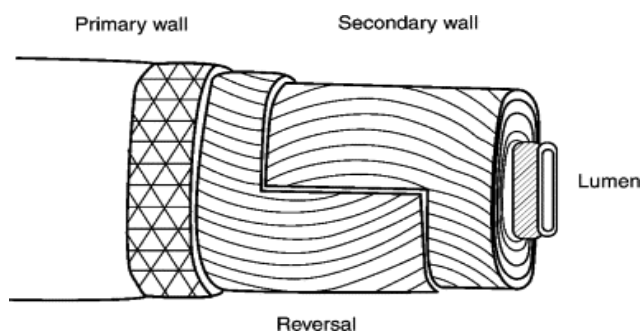

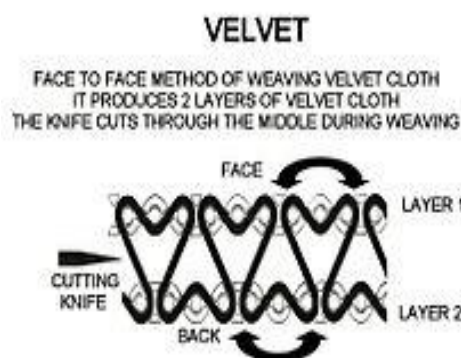
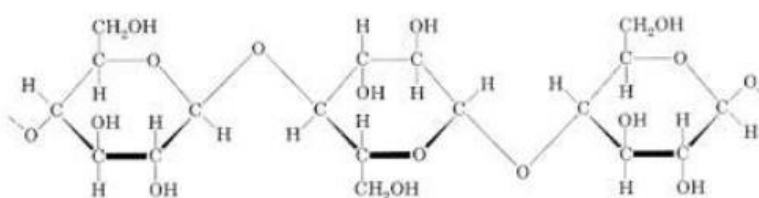

- Structure of Hemi Cellulose.

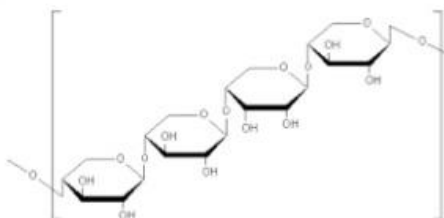

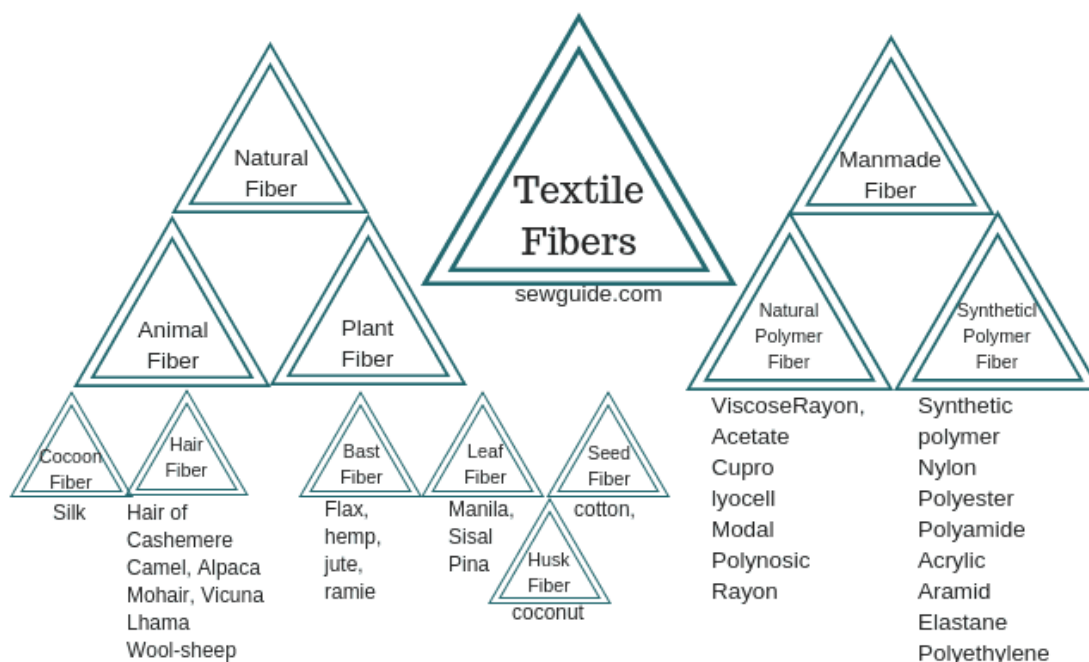

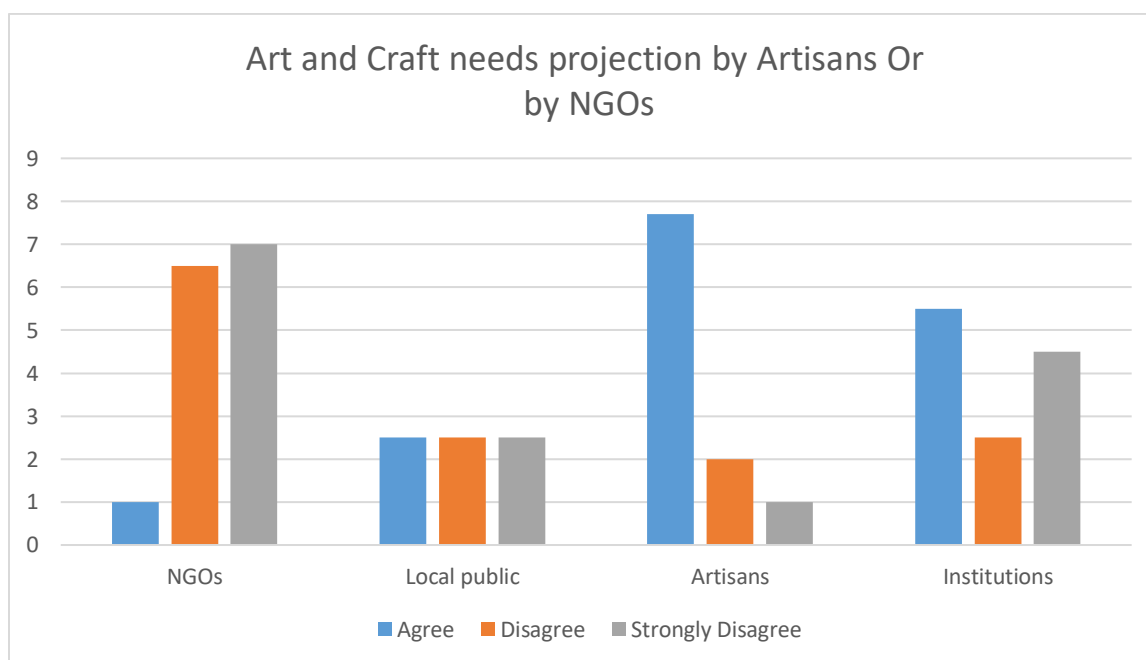

NGOs never furnished responses in light of a legitimate concern for craftsmans and made a decent attempt to persuade that really they were/are supporting craftsmans by extending to them employment opportunities in their areas else they were sitting weak in their homes and couldn't satisfy the fundamental necessities bread and butter for their lives. Which is and will be an off-base assertion in the genuine methods and sense.

Then again craftsmans accepted that the genuine workmanship and specialty advancement and projection ought to be under the pennant of craftsmans and not by the various NGOs.

While the organizations appears to acquaint the craftsmans and need with bring back the lost acclaim of the specialty chiefs and the nearby open has no interest what's going on around them they were occupied

in their own lives without caring what is passing on and what need to make sure about. Which is should be featured in might be some other study.
